The so-called “international classification” comprises 45 classes of products and services. Unless otherwise specified above, the “CROSSBOW” device mark has been registered for the following specification of goods and services of Swiss origin:

Class 1:

Chemicals used in industry, science and photography, as well as in agriculture, horticulture and forestry; unprocessed artificial resins, unprocessed plastics; manures; fire extinguishing compositions; tempering and soldering preparations; chemical substances for preserving foodstuffs; tanning substances; adhesives used in industry.

Class 2:

Paints, varnishes, lacquers; preservatives against rust and against deterioration of wood; colorants; mordants; raw natural resins; metals in foil and powder form for painters, decorators, printers and artists.

Class 3:

Bleaching preparations and other substances for laundry use; cleaning, polishing, scouring and abrasive preparations; soaps; perfumery, essential oils, cosmetics, hair lotions; dentifrices.

Class 4:

Industrial oils and greases; lubricants; dust absorbing, wetting and binding products; fuels (including motor spirit) and illuminants; candles and wicks for lighting.

Class 5:

Industrial oils and greases; lubricants; dust absorbing, wetting and binding products; fuels (including motor spirit) and illuminants; candles and wicks for lighting.

Class 6:

Pharmaceutical and veterinary preparations; sanitary preparations for medical purposes; dietetic substances adapted for medical use, food for babies; plasters, materials for dressings; material for stopping teeth, dental wax; disinfectants; preparations for destroying vermin; fungicides, herbicides; deodorants.

Class 7:

Machines and machine tools, as well as their parts and accessories (included in this class); motors and engines (except for land vehicles) as well as their parts and accessories (included in this class); machine coupling and transmission components (except for land vehicles); agricultural implements other than hand-operated; incubators for eggs; sets of tools (machine parts); tools, apparatus and instruments operated mechanically (included in this class); electromechanical appliances and instruments for household and kitchen use.

Class 8:

Hand tools and implements (hand-operated), as well as their parts and accessories (included in this class); cutlery; side arms; razors.

Class 9:

Scientific, nautical, surveying, photographic, cinematographic, optical, weighing, measuring, signalling, checking (supervision), life-saving and teaching apparatus and instruments; apparatus for recording, transmission, reproduction of data, sound or images; apparatus and instruments for conducting, switching, transforming, accumulating, regulating or controlling electricity; electronic, optical and magnetic recording media; recording discs; automatic vending machines and mechanisms for coin-operated apparatus; cash registers, calculating machines, data processing equipment; hardware and software for computers as well as their devices and peripheral instruments; fire extinguishing apparatus; components, spare parts and accessories (included in this class) for all aforementioned goods.

Class 10:

Surgical, medical, dental and veterinary apparatus and instruments, as well as their parts and accessories (included in this class); artificial limbs, eyes and teeth; orthopaedic articles; suture materials; special clothing for operating theatres, special furniture and mirrors for medical use.

Class 11:

Apparatus for lighting, heating, steam generating, cooking, refrigerating, drying, ventilating, water supply and sanitary purposes; components and accessories (included in this class) for all the aforesaid goods.

Class 12:

Vehicles as well as their parts and accessories (included in this class); apparatus for locomotion by land, air or water, as well as their parts and accessories (included in this class).

Class 13:

Firearms; ammunition and projectiles; explosives; fireworks.

Class 14:

Precious metals and their alloys and goods in precious metals or coated therewith, not included in other classes; jewellery, precious stones; horological and chronometric instruments as well as their parts and accessories (included in this class).

Class 15:

Musical instruments as well as their parts and accessories (included in this class).

Class 16:

Paper, cardboard and goods made from these materials, not included in other classes; printed matter; bookbinding material; photographs; stationery; adhesives for stationery or household purposes; artists' materials; paintbrushes; typewriters and office requisites (except furniture) as well as their parts and accessories (included in this class); instructional and teaching material (except apparatus); plastic materials for packaging (not included in other classes); printers' type; printing blocks.

Class 17:

Rubber, gutta-percha, gum, asbestos, mica and goods made from these materials and not included in other classes; plastics in extruded form for use in manufacture; packing, stopping and insulating materials, as well as their parts and accessories (included in this class); flexible pipes, not of metal.

Class 18:

Leather and imitations of leather, and goods made of these materials and not included in other classes; animal skins, hides; trunks and travelling bags; umbrellas, parasols and walking sticks; whips, harness and saddlery; rucksacks, bags (included in this class), as well as components and accessories (included in this class) for all travelling bags, umbrellas and parasols, walking sticks, whips, harness and saddlery and bags.

Class 19:

Non-metallic building elements; non-metallic rigid pipes for building; asphalt, pitch and bitumen; non-metallic transportable buildings; monuments, not of metal; building materials (non-metallic).

Class 11:

Furniture, mirrors, picture frames; goods (not included in other classes) of wood, cork, reed, cane, wicker, horn, bone, ivory, whalebone, shell, amber, mother-of-pearl, meerschaum, and substitutes for all these materials, or of plastics; bedding (except linen).

Class 21:

Household or kitchen utensils and containers, as well as their parts and accessories (included in this class); combs and sponges; brushes (except paintbrushes); brush-making materials; articles for cleaning purposes; steelwool; unworked or semi-worked glass (except glass used in building); glassware, porcelain and earthenware not included in other classes.

Class 22:

Ropes, string, nets, tents, awnings, tarpaulins, sails, sacks and bags (not included in other classes); padding and stuffing materials (except of rubber or plastics); raw fibrous textile materials.

Class 23:

Yarns and threads, for textile use.

Class 24:

Textiles and textile goods, not included in other classes; bed and table covers.

Class 25:

Clothing, footwear, headgear.

Class 26:

Lace and embroidery, ribbons and braid; buttons, hooks and eyes, pins and needles; artificial flowers; fastenings for clothing.

Class 27:

Carpets, rugs, mats and matting, linoleum and other materials for covering existing floors; wall hangings (non-textile).

Class 28:

Games and playthings; gymnastic and sporting articles not included in other classes; decorations for Christmas trees; components and accessories (included in this class) for all the aforesaid goods.

Class 29:

Meat, fish, poultry and game; meat extracts; preserved, frozen, dried and cooked fruits and vegetables; jellies, jams, compotes; eggs, milk and dairy products; edible oils and fats; preparations, ready-made dishes and beverages made with the above products.

Class 30:

Coffee, tea, cocoa, sugar, rice, tapioca, sago, artificial coffee; flours and preparations made from cereals, bread, pastry and confectionery, ices; honey, treacle; yeast, baking-powder; salt, mustard; vinegar, sauces (condiments); spices; ice for refreshment; chocolate and chocolate products; preparations, ready-made dishes and beverages made with the above products.

Class 31:

Agricultural, horticultural and forestry products and grains, not included in other classes; live animals; fresh fruits and vegetables; seeds, natural plants and flowers; foodstuffs for animals; malt.

Class 32:

Beers; mineral and aerated waters and other non-alcoholic drinks; fruit drinks and fruit juices; syrups and other preparations for making beverages.

Class 33:

Alcoholic beverages (except beers).

Class 34:

Tobacco; smokers' articles; matches; tobacco products.

Class 35:

Advertising; business management; business administration; office functions; employment agencies; personnel consulting; personnel management consultancy; operation of an import-export agency; retailing of goods of all kinds; retailing by means of electronic global computer networks (the Internet); systematic organization and/or compilation of data in computer data banks; rental including provisioning and reprovisioning of automatic vending machines; rental of office apparatus; providing commercial know-how (franchising); promotional sponsorship.

Class 36:

Insurance; financial affairs; monetary affairs; real estate affairs.

Class 37:

Building construction; repair; installation services; rental of tools, equipment and machines in all the above fields.

Class 38:

Telecommunications; rental of telecommunication equipment.

Class 39:

Transport; packaging and storage of goods; travel arrangement; services of a travel agency; vehicle rental.

Class 40:

Treatment of materials; rental of equipment, machines and installations for use in the treatment of materials.

Class 41:

Education; providing of training; entertainment; sporting and cultural activities; rental of audio or video equipment and of print or electronically recorded media; services of a careers advisor.

Class 42:

Scientific and technological services and research and design relating thereto; industrial analysis and research services; design and development of computer hardware and software; services of a data bank, namely rental of access time to computer files (computing services); licensing of intellectual property rights; making available technical know-how (franchising).

Class 43:

Services for providing food and drink; temporary accommodation; services of children's day-care centers and rest and convalescent homes.

Class 44:

Medical services; veterinary services; hygienic and beauty care for human beings or animals; agriculture, horticulture and forestry services; convalescent home services; florists' services.

Class 45:

Legal services; security services for the protection of property and individuals; personal and social services rendered by others to meet the needs of individuals, namely dating services, marriage agencies, escorting in society (chaperoning), undertakers' services; services for providing security of property and people.
